OER Fellowship requirements

- Assign OER as the ****only required course material**** in Fall 2018
- Participate in 4 library workshops during Spring 2018
- Deliver curated OER housed on the City Tech OpenLab (<http://openlab.citytech.cuny.edu>) in accordance with all evaluation criteria due June 2018 - payment disbursed in July
- Participate in faculty presentation addressing the OER curation process and findings from classroom adoption (Fall 2018)
- Prepare a brief written report about classroom application based on library guidelines (due January 2019)

Tentative Fellowship seminar schedule: As part of the Fellowship, you will participate in a series of 4 seminars during the Spring semester. Seminars will be held on 4 Fridays and I'll do my best to make sure they're coordinated around other teaching/professional conflicts to the extent that it's possible (stay tuned for a scheduling poll).
